Chapter: Vacation with My Nani Ma (Maths Mela)

Activity Description:

Students are required to complete the following two activities for the chapter Vacation with My Nani Ma:

1. Travel Addition and Subtraction: My Journey

Write the distance in km from your home to Nani Ma's house. Add the distance for going and coming back. Then subtract one way from the total to check. Example: Home to Nani Ma = 45 km. $45 + 45 = 90$ km total. $90 - 45 = 45$ km one way. Show your working in columns.

2. Real Life Activity: Nani Ma's Market List

Make a shopping list of 4 items Nani Ma might buy from the market with prices. Add the cost of any two items. Then subtract one item from the total. Draw or paste pictures of the items. Example: Milk Rs. 28 + Fruits Rs. 40 = Rs. 68. Rs. 68 - Milk Rs. 28 = Rs. 40.
