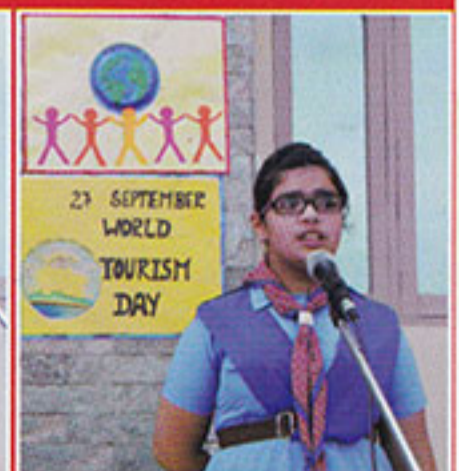
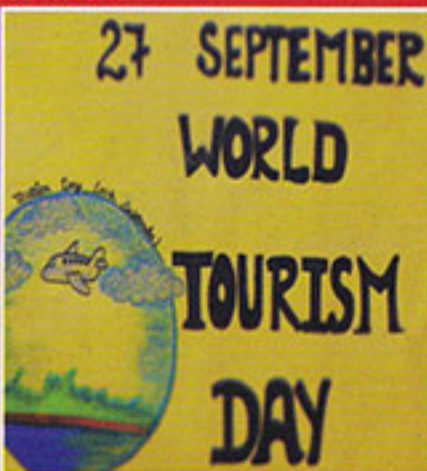
INTERNATIONAL OZONE DAY 16th Sep 2016
