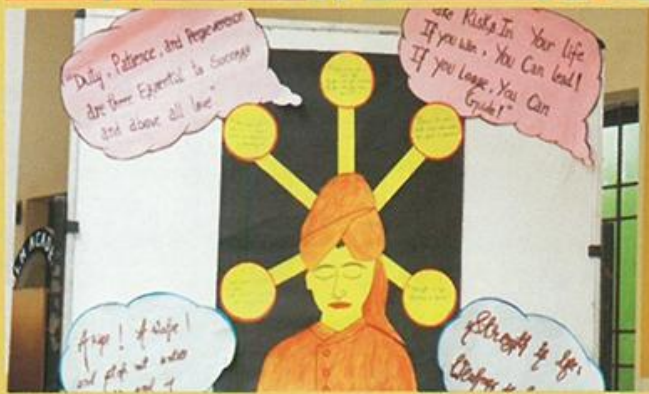
## Vivekanand Jayanti

हमारे मन में कभी ये ख्याल आया है कि ये जानवर कहाँ से आते हैं, इन्हें कौन छोड़ देता है ?

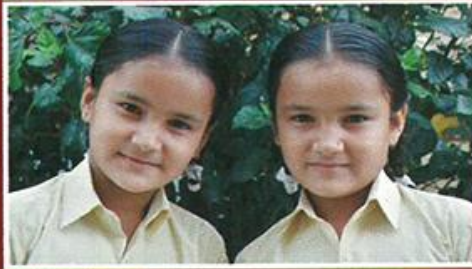

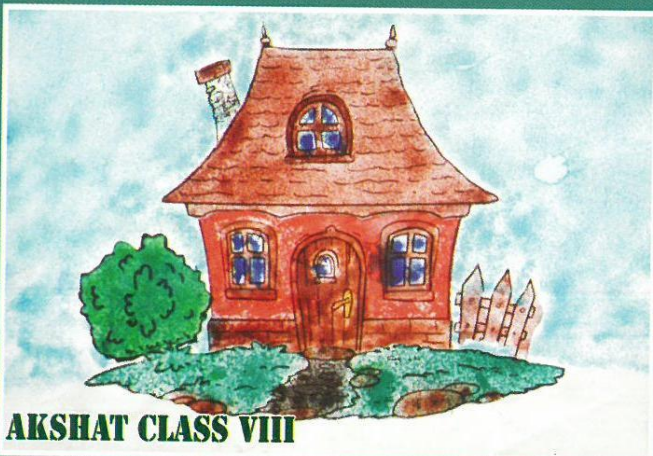
इतनी नकारात्मकता! आखिर कैसे संवरेगा यह विश्व समाज ?
