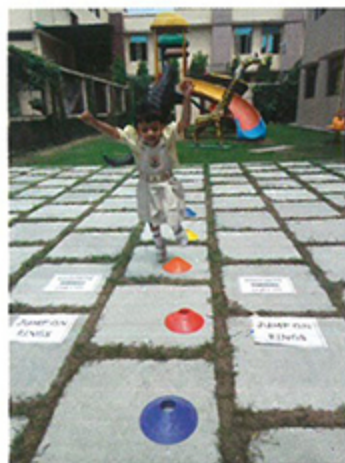

### World Ozone Day (16-09-2017)

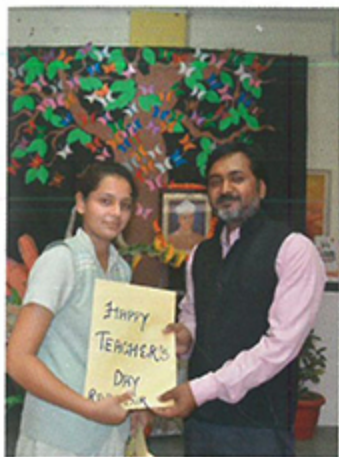

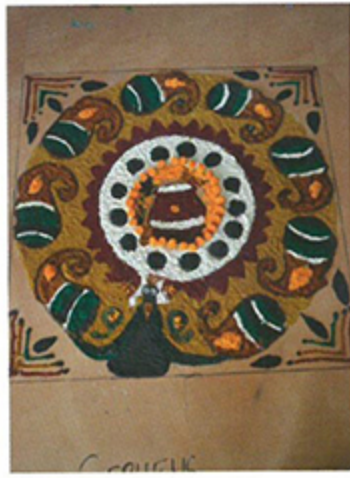
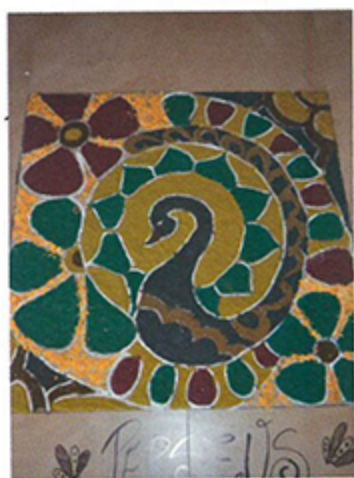
